

SIMI VALLEY TASK FORCE ON HEROIN PREVENTION - MEETING NOTES
TUESDAY, APRIL 10, 2012

- City Council Member Mike Judge was nominated and approved for the position of Chair.
- Clerk of the Simi Valley Board of Education Rob Collins was nominated and approved for the position of Vice Chair.
- Members of the public made statements during Public Comments and offered their assistance to the Task Force.
- The Task Force directed that no sub-committees be formed and all discussion take place with the entire Task Force at publicly noticed meetings.
- The Task Force directed that five additional meetings be scheduled, one to address each of the following topics:
 - The resources offered by the Simi Valley Unified School District for drug prevention and education;
 - The resources and programs offered by the City of Simi Valley in the Police Department and Community Services Department;
 - The resources offered by the Rancho Simi Recreation and Park District;
 - A presentation similar to that presented by the Drug Enforcement Agency in November on heroin and other drugs; and
 - A discussion of all presentations received with recommendations for next steps.
- The next meeting was set for Monday, April 30, 2012 from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. in the City Council Chamber at City Hall.
