ACTIVITIES

Because of the importance the District places on the diversity of summer programming, we are able to draw from vast resources. A sample of what may be provided includes:

GENERAL INFORMATION

WHO: Boys and girls entering kindergarten through sixth grades as of September, 2011.

WHEN: Ten (10) one-week sessions beginning June 13 through August 19, 2011.

TIME: Supervision begins at 6:45 a.m. and ends at 6 p.m. Planned programs start at 9 a.m. and will run until 5 p.m.

STAFF: Day camp staff have been carefully chosen and trained by professional staff including certifications in First Aid and CPR. They have diverse areas of expertise and are caring, enthusiastic and energetic.

WHY SIMI DAY CAMP?

Sequoia, Crosstown Kids and Rancho Day Camps have been designed to meet the needs and expectations of parents and campers alike. We provide an environment that is productive and caring yet professional and safe. The District has over 40 years of experience in providing recreation services and provides a diverse spectrum of activities directed by energetic, enthusiastic and supportive staff. We strive to tap and develop individual interests, to fulfill special needs while providing a fun, exciting summer.

REGISTER BEFORE MAY 6 & SAVE \$30

A \$30 registration fee will be waived for persons registering on or before 5:00 p.m., May 6, 2011. Mail or drop off camp registration forms at 1692 Sycamore Drive, Simi Valley.

FEES AND CHARGES

PRE-REGISTRATION: A one-time \$30.00 summer pre-registration fee per child will be charged upon enrollment. Fee includes one T-shirt. Additional shirts: \$8.00 each.

SESSION REGISTRATION FEES: Sessions are one week in length. The fee includes all materials, supplies, recreational swimming and supervision. Registration is limited. Register now.

PAYMENTS: For first week your child attends camp, all completed paperwork and fees must be received in the District office by 12:00 p.m. the Thursday before that week. Additional weeks of camp registration will be charged using an autopay system (debit, Visa, or MasterCard) on a weekly basis. All registration is on a first-come, first-serve basis. If a receipt is desired, please call the District office.

DISCOUNTS: Families with more than one child registered for a week may take a \$15 discount for each additional child. (T-shirts and registration fee excluded.)

FIELD TRIPS: Field Trips are **NOT** included in the Day Camp fee. Each trip has a separate fee. Space is limited. Child must be registered in a camp in order to attend that week's trip. For your child to attend a field trip, you must indicate that interest on the camp's "Field Trips" form.



RELATED INFORMATION

1. **Registration changes must be made *NO LATER THAN 12:00 p.m.* the Thursday prior to the next week of attendance. However, registration is on a first-come, first serve basis. We cannot guarantee space for your child. Charges will be made each Friday.**
2. The last day of camp is August 19. **See-Me After School Clubs begin Wednesday, August 24, 2011.**
3. Children may be signed in or out any time between 6:45 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.
4. Children must bring a sack lunch (NO LUNCH PAILS PLEASE) everyday unless otherwise indicated. Please write child's name on the lunch! Daily snacks will also be provided.
5. Please apply sun block or sun screen every day before coming to camp.
6. An RSRPD camp T-shirt is MANDATORY for all field trips.
7. Enclosed shoes are required daily. No sandals.
8. Parents are responsible for transportation to and from camp sites. Children may only be signed out by an authorized parent/guardian as indicated on registration form, or by special arrangement.

10. A \$10.00 fee per 15 minutes per portion thereof will be assessed for late pick-ups.
11. **Children who have not been picked up by 6:30 p.m. may be released into the custody of the Simi Valley Police Department.**
12. Children will be placed in small groups based on a combination of age and maturity.
13. All events, activities, trips, and policies are subject to change without notice.
14. Children not attending field trips will remain at the Day Camp site under the supervision of a counselor. Field trip attendance is limited.
15. Money and valuables (radios, etc.) should not be brought to camp. There are no lockers or checking facilities.
16. **SWIMMING**—Each camp will offer one day that includes recreational swimming from 1:00-3:30 pm.
Sequoia Camp—Friday
Crosstown Kids Camp—Wednesday
Rancho Camp—Friday
On these days, parents should drop off and pick up their children at Rancho Simi Community Park. Regulation swimming suits are required. Other recreational activities will also be part of the day's program.
17. **Suspension or Dismissal From Camp**—For the protection and harmony of all campers, we have established certain safety and disciplinary rules which all children are required to follow. If a child violates any of these rules, such conduct can lead to the child's suspension or dismissal from camp.
18. **Illness Policy**—Ill children will not be accepted into camp. If a child becomes ill during the camp, parents or authorized persons will be contacted to pick up the child. Children cannot attend the camps if the following occur:
 - A fever over 100 degrees
 - Vomiting with or without fever
 - Diarrhea, with or without fever
 - Unexplained rash with or without fever
 - Unexplained discharge from eyes, ears, nose, mouth or skin
19. **Medication Policy**—Rancho Simi Recreation and Park District requires a signed permission slip authorizing the staff to administer medication (prescription or over-the-counter). Medicines must be accompanied by a doctor's note and signature. All medication must be in the original container or prescription bottle. All instructions for administering medication must be on the label.
20. **Accidents and Injuries**—If a child become hurt during camp, appropriate first aid will be applied. Parents will be notified of all injuries in writing or verbal. For accidents or injuries that require immediate medical attention, 911 will be called and parent/emergency contacts will be called as soon as possible. Please sign and return the medical emergency release form included in your child's enrollment packet. The program will always have a trained first aid and CPR certified staff member on the premises.

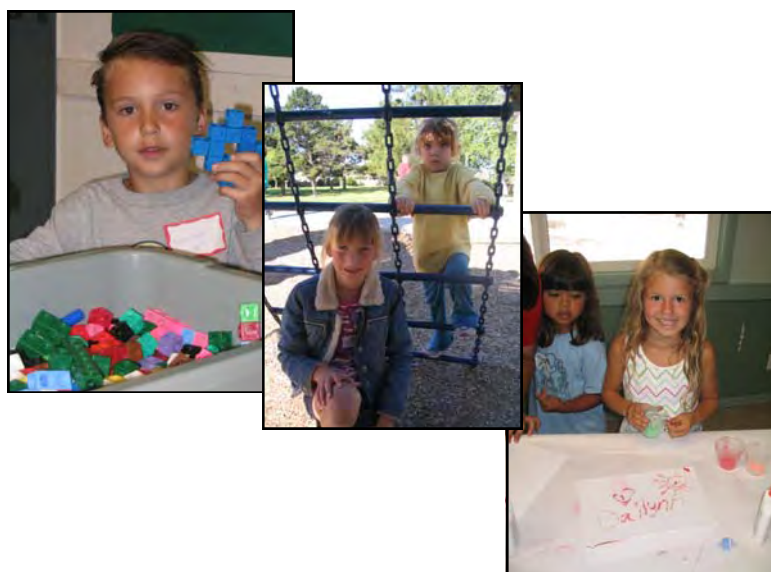
